OVERALL COLLEGE RATE: 87% of the graduates are employed.

61% of the graduates are working in their field; the average (related) salary is \$30,169.

87% of the employed graduates are working in the State of Maine.

65% of the employed graduates are working in Aroostook County  
201 total degrees were conferred on 195 students

SUCCESS RATE: 92% of the graduates are employed, continuing their education or both.

76% of the graduates are working in the State of Maine

56% of the graduates who are working full-time, part-time or working while continuing their education, are working in Aroostook County.

The median weighted salary for graduates who are employed full-time in their field is \$23,806. The average weighted salary for the same group is \$29,908.
