The goal of the Doc4aDay program is to ignite a spark of interest in high school students to explore a career as a physician. The program consists of a presentation on the pathway to a health care career, direct involvement in simulated patient scenarios, hands-on clinical activities in a skills lab (such as suturing pigs' feet) and a round table lunch discussion with MMC-Tufts Medical Students and Residents.

Target Audience

Promising high school students who have the interest and potential for a career as a physician, especially those who may be socially, economically or otherwise disadvantaged.

Registration Process

Students can be identified in a variety of ways depending on what internal process works best for the individual school. Ultimately, the counselor (or designated person) will complete and return a recommendation form, a signed parental consent form and media release form for each participant. Selection of the 12 participants will be achieved from this pool of applicants.
