

PROGRAM PURPOSE

The entrepreneurship certificate level program is designed to prepare prospective entrepreneurs to launch new ventures by educating them in the fundamentals of starting and operating their own business. For entrepreneurs who already have established a business, this program will help them strengthen their business and management skills.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Entrepreneurship is an employment strategy that can lead to economic self-sufficiency. Self-employment provides people and their families with the potential to create and manage businesses in which they function as the employer or boss, rather than merely being an employee.

Graduates who want to expand their business management skills further can go on to complete the business administration associate degree program at NMCC; students may be able to apply 26 of the 32 credits earned toward an AAS in business administration.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The following procedures constitute the admissions process:

1. Submit an NMCC application along with a \$20 application fee.
2. Submit official high school transcript and/or HiSET/GED scores (current senior's transcript should include completed ranking period grades).
3. Official college transcripts for applicants who have attended other post-secondary schools.
4. If SAT scores are not available, placement testing will be required.
5. Individual interview required.
A campus tour is highly recommended.
