OVERALL COLLEGE RATE: 86% of the graduates are employed.

SUCCESS RATE: 95% of the graduates are employed, continuing education or both.

73% of the graduates are working in their field; the average (related) salary is \$30,092.

80% of the graduates are working in the State of Maine.

93% of the employed graduates are working in the State of Maine.

55% of the graduates are working in Aroostook County.

64% of the employed graduates are working in Aroostook County.

The median weighted starting salary for graduates who are employed full-time in their field is \$27,820. The average weighted salary for the same group is \$29,792.

217 total degrees were conferred on 206 people.

10 people received more than one credential.

Of the 206 surveys sent, we received responses from 193.
