OVERALL COLLEGE RATE: 86% of the graduates are employed.

SUCCESS RATE: 96% of the graduates are employed, continuing education or both.

68% of the graduates are working in their field; the average (related) salary is \$28,487.

71% of the graduates are working in the State of Maine.

54% of the graduates working full time, part time, or working while continuing their education, are working in Aroostook County.

82% of the employed graduates are working in the State of Maine.

63% of the employed graduates entering directly into the workforce, are working in Aroostook County.

The median weighted starting salary for graduates who are employed full-time in their field is \$27,040. The average weighted salary for the same group is \$28,174.

211 total degrees were conferred on 192 people.

16 people received more than one credential.
