- Personal interview
- Valid Maine driver's license and a review of your driving record*
- High School diploma or GED
- Immunization record/proof of: MMR or titer indicating immunity; Diphtheria/ tetanus given in the past 10 years
- *Driving record will be reviewed in order to meet eligibility requirements, as specified by employers. NOTE: Students will be required to provide appropriate working attire. Industry-specific protective gear, including work boots and gloves, will be provided by the program.
