

MEDICAL ASSISTING

PROGRAM PURPOSE

Medical assistants are multi-skilled health professionals specifically trained to work in a variety of healthcare settings, performing both clinical and administrative duties. NMCC offers a one-year certificate in medical assisting as well as an Associate of Applied Science degree. Students learn a range of clinical and administrative skills through both classroom instruction and hands-on experience.

To graduate from the program, students must complete a 165-hour externship at an approved ambulatory healthcare setting. During this externship, students apply the skills they have learned in the classroom and laboratory. Graduates of the program will be competent, entry-level medical assistants, capable of working in various healthcare settings.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates of the medical assisting program will be competent medical assistants who secure employment in medical offices or ambulatory clinics. In the State of Maine, medical assistants work under the direction of healthcare providers.

Graduates of the program are eligible to sit for the Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) national certification exam administered by the American Association of Medical Assistants (AAMA).

This program equips you with essential skills. As a certified medical assistant, you'll play a crucial part in patient care, from taking vital signs and assisting with examinations to managing patient records and coordinating appointments. With a growing demand for healthcare professionals, this certificate opens doors to numerous job opportunities and career advancement.



APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The following procedures constitute the admissions process:

- 1 Submit an NMCC application.
- Submit official high school
 transcript and/or HiSET/GED
 scores (current senior's ranking period grades).
- Official college transcripts for applicants who have attended other post-secondary schools.
- If SAT scores are not available,placement testing may be required.
- 5 Meet with Admissions Counselor.
- 6 A campus tour is highly recommended.

Note: Criminal history record search will be completed by NMCC personnel. Prior criminal convictions may preclude program admission and licensure.
