POSITION TITLE: Emergency Medical Services (EMS) instructor

- Adequate training and experience in the delivery of pre-hospital emergency care at appropriate level including proper care and transport of patients, medical direction, and quality improvement in pre-hospital care.
- Thorough knowledge of National EMS education standards and the ability to teach all scheduled curriculum set forth by the National EMS standards accurately and in a positive manner.
- Ability to effectively provide instruction on assigned subject(s) as a result of academic preparation, training/experience, and perform all skills associated with course subject matter correctly, efficiently and with proficiency.
- Current working knowledge of and experience with Maine EMS treatment protocols.
- Knowledge of or willingness to participate in training for Fisdap program.
