Nathaniel's Journey

Nathaniel Levesque is a 2021 Computer & Network Technology graduate of Northern Maine Community College. He now is co-owner of Fantasy Game Center, an electronics and video game store and repair business.

A lifelong interest in computers and electronics led Levesque to further education in the field at NMCC to explore the possibility of pursuing the interest as a career. While working through the classes in the program, Levesque progressed part-time at a pace that worked best for him. The knowledge and hands-on experience from his courses laid a solid foundation for the technical work Levesque performs in his business.

During college, Levesque worked as a waiter at Ruby Tuesday's, where he built other valuable skills such as customer service and sales experience. He also says that the job helped him build multi-tasking and prioritizing skills. After graduating from NMCC, Levesque worked briefly at another electronics repairs establishment before deciding that he was interested in building an independent business.

Creating a Career Path

As small business owners, Nathaniel Levesque and Albert Anderson are responsible for all parts of their growing business. At Fantasy Game Center, they repair electronics such as desktops, laptops, and cell phones and refurbish video gaming consoles for the store. Customer satisfaction is a high priority for Levesque, who works to keep the costs of electronics repairs lower than the competition and affordable for Aroostook County families. Fantasy Game Center also has a large selection of pre-owned games in their store on North Street in Presque Isle.

For people looking to begin college, Levesque's advice is "make sure you are making the right choice for you; even if it takes more time before making a choice, that's okay." Evaluate your interests and grow at your own pace rather than being focused on the influence of others.
