**QUALIFICATIONS:** Preferred bachelor's degree in biology, environmental studies or a related field; a minimum of 5 years of occupational experience directly related to water or waste water treatment operations and management. Hold a minimum of **Class III Water License and/or Grade III Waste Water Certification (or the ability to obtain licensure within 12 months)**.

Teaching/training experience including working with diverse adults to meet learning objectives is preferred. Mix of theoretical and practical knowledge and the ability to communicate the information is important. Demonstrated ability to work with technology to prepare presentations and identify appropriate materials and equipment for training.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** The WTT faculty has primary responsibility for the WTT program including recruitment, curriculum development, instruction, and student guidance. Will need to instruct on-campus, on-line and potentially at off-site locations in the operation and maintenance of water and/or waste water treatment systems (including water distribution, waste water collection, and treatment systems. This person will collaborate with current industry personnel in the development of curriculum that meets identified industry workforce skills for students to gain employment and ultimately obtain State of Maine Water and/or Waste Water Certifications.
